1) What time is check out?

a) Check out is @ 10:00am.

2) What do we need to do at check out?

a) **Most important!! - Please make sure to leave the house keys on the table before you leave!**

b) Make sure and lock the both locks on the back (Lake) door.

c) Lock only the deadbolt via the electronic lock on the front (Hillside) door. Please do not lock the doorknob.

3) Who do we call if there is a problem?

a) EMERGENCIES

i) As mentioned prior to your booking, the cabin does not have phone service. In case of emergency, please call 911 from your cell phone.

ii) If you are unable to connect to your cell phone, you may try to contact the neighbors to the south, **Joe and Melody Eve** for assistance.

b) NON-EMERGENCIES

i) Please call **Lori Spilker first @ 208-818-3399**. If you are unable to reach Lori, then please call **Ahren Spilker @ 208-661-2644**. If we are unable to answer your call, please leave your message and we will call you back ASAP.

4) Where do we put the trash?

a) If you are staying longer than a few days, you may accumulate trash. Please place ALL Trash into trash bags provided (located under the kitchen sink). The trash should be placed in the trash cans located on the east side of the garage (there is a sign). **DO NOT LEAVE UNSECURED TRASH OUTSIDE!!!** This can attract bears, raccoons, and mountain lions which you would rather avoid, not to mention the mess that will surely follow.

- b) Make sure you place all trash in the trash bins provided and make sure the gate is secured and the trash can lids are secured. DO NOT LEAVE TRASH SITTING OUT FOR ANY REASON.
- c) If the trash cans are full due to your extended stay, there is a trash dump located in the town of Lakeside. I have attached a map at the end of this to show its location. This is a public site with no fee and we recommend its use if you accumulate more than a bag or two of extra trash.

5) Who does the German Shepard belong too?

- a) The dog's name is "Matador" and he belongs to the neighbors to the south of us, Joe and Melody Eve. Don't worry, he is very friendly.

6) Can we use the tree house?

- a) No. The tree house is strictly off limits and has been secured so that entry is prohibited. Please do not play on or around.

7) We did not sign up to use the canoe, can we still use it?

- a) Unfortunately due to the high liability we must have secured your completed and signed usage agreement prior to your arrival. If you have the ability to download & print the agreement from our website: <http://Inuistmalt.weebly.com/documents-and-forms.html> . We will accept a signed and emailed copy sent to Ahren Spilker at awspilke@hotmail.com . You must call us and let us know if you plan to do this so we can give you instructions.

8) Where can I rent a boat?

- a) The nearest place to rent a boat is Wild Wave Rentals in Lakeside, MT (406) 844-2400.

9) Can we use the boat lift?

- a) No. Use of the boat lift is strictly prohibited. Please do not allow children to play on or around the lift as it can be very dangerous.

10) There are missing items in the cabin. What should we do?

- a) Please make a note of what is missing and call Lori or Ahren Spilker and we will try to make arrangements to have those items replaced as soon as we can.

11) We broke something or caused damage. What do we do?

- a) All rentals were required to purchase rental insurance at the time of booking. This insurance covers incidental damage/loss. Please submit to Ahren Spilker in writing what damage has occurred with photos if possible and we will handle the claim with the insurance company.
- b) Please note that any damage in excess of the coverage by the insurance policy purchased by the renter is the sole responsibility of the renter.

12) We have pets, are they safe outside at night?

a) Maybe. We are in a wilderness area. Bears, cougars and other animals are known to be in the area. Pets should be safely crated or secured either in a vehicle or in the residence.

13) Do we need to worry about dangerous animals at the cabin?

a) In general no. In all the years we have lived and stayed at the cabin, we have only seen two bears (both times late at night). We have heard and seen the resulting damage (i.e. bear/cougar/raccoon in the trash bins) but have never personally encountered them.

That being said, please be diligent and follow these guidelines:

i) **DO NOT STORE UNSECURED TRASH OUTSIDE.** This is the number one attractant of undesirable animals. Use the trash cans provided that are located at the garage and make sure the containers are secured.

ii) Do not store food outside. Storage of food items in the mini fridge at the dock is fine, but don't leave other food out.

iii) Bats are prevalent in the area and tend to roost on the back deck corners. They are harmless if left alone. In fact they are very beneficial in keeping the mosquito population at extremely low levels. Bats are good! (Albeit a bit messy).

14) What do we do if we can't get something to work or are having problems?

a) Please do not hesitate to call us. We will be happy to try and walk you through any issues or concerns you may have.

Directions to the Lakeside Public Waste disposal:




Drive 4.0 miles, 10 min
